We Respect Your Privacy

We will collect and process information in accordance with the following policies:

1. We respect your personal information and undertake to comply with applicable Data Protection legislation.
2. We confirm that any personal details, which you provide to us (or which are available on public registers) from which we can identify you, are held in accordance with our Data Protection Registration Notification. When you register your details with us, we consider the information you input as private.
3. In the event that your personal information is no longer used by us for the purposes outlined in these policies, we will delete it except insofar as it is necessary to retain such information to comply with other relevant or applicable law.
4. In the event that your personal data becomes untrue, inaccurate, or incomplete, or in any event, you have the right to gain access to your personal data and may rectify the same.
5. The information we collect may be accessed by the UBA and ourselves. Information is only shared with our partners who abide by our privacy policy. We may disclose your personal data to any member of our Group,
6. We allow our members to access their own information where this relates to account.

You agree that you do not object to us, or such third parties contacting you for any of the above purposes whether by telephone, e-mail or in writing and you confirm that you do not and will not consider any of the above as being a breach of any of your rights under any Regulations or the equivalent under local applicable law.
